Next up is our dark and luscious 2019 Durell Vineyard Pinot Noir from the Sonoma Coast AVA. Rich with layers of flavors, this wine has depth and elegance with a soft, full mouthfeel, dark fruits and a lingering, beautiful finish.

And last but certainly not least, experience our rich and rugged pinot noir from Thorn Ridge Vineyard. This masculine, big tannin pinot noir from the Sonoma Coast is structured and dense with flavors and aromatics of bright cherry, cedar and forest grove. This wine is definitely a hard hitter to decant before enjoying so it will open up beautifully.

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2021 ROSÉ || SONOMA COUNTY

For our 2021 vintage, we decided to shift our vineyard sourcing to Sonoma County and expand the palette of varietals we work with for our Banshee Rosé. We source from select vineyards including parts of our Single Vineyard program, and the final blend is comprised of seven varietals produced from seven sub-appellations within the Sonoma County AVA.

VARIETAL COMPOSITION: 50% Pinot Noir, 32% Sangiovese, 8% Syrah, 5% Black Muscat, 2% Carignan, 2% Muscat, 1% Zinfandel

VINEYARDS: 100% Sonoma County

TASTING: The 2021 Sonoma County Rosé is a lovely shade of pale salmon with aromas of orange blossom, guava, creamsicle and fresh-picked strawberries. Bright, mouth-watering flavors of juicy strawberry-apple and watermelon are highlighted by hints of ripe Meyer lemon, minerality and a soft creamsicle finish. Racy acidity and elegance are balanced perfectly in this dry, crisp rosé.



2019 PINOT NOIR || SONOMA COUNTY

Our vineyard selection for the Sonoma County Pinot has continued to grow and improve over the years. We source from select vineyards including parts of our Single Vineyard program, and the final blend includes ten different clonal selections. This is the most important wine in the Banshee lineup, and we treat it as such.

VARIETAL COMPOSITION: 100% Pinot Noir

VINEYARDS: 100% Sonoma County

TASTING: An exciting, yet friendly wine, bursting at the seams with aromas of macerated tart cherries, pomegranate and notes of earth and pine. The flavors combine both sweet and tart with a fruit driven front palate and very subtle oak influence. The finish is bright, slightly herbal, and delicate making this an excellent food wine, as well as a charming drinking experience by itself.



2019 PINOT NOIR || DURELL VINEYARD

92 Points, James Suckling

Durell Vineyard is situated in the rocky, volcanic soil of this 150-acre lot, bisecting the Sonoma Valley, Sonoma Coast, and Carneros AVAs. Durell Vineyard is planted on the eastern facing hillsides in well-drained Goulting Cobbly clay loam soil. Sitting in the heart of Sonoma, this site is exposed to both the San Francisco Bay and Pacific Ocean influences that combine to produce wines of extraordinary depth.

VARIETAL COMPOSITION: 100% Pinot Noir

VINEYARD: Durell Vineyard, Sonoma Coast

TASTING: This rich, deep pinot noir has aromatics of freshly tilled soil and dark fruits that lead to flavors of juicy wild strawberry, blackberry, fig and cherry pie. This luscious, dark and brooding pinot noir with intense tannins lingers on the palate and finishes with a hint of vanilla and cola.



2018 PINOT NOIR || THORN RIDGE VINEYARD

Thorn Ridge Vineyard is owned and farmed by legendary Sonoma grower, Ted Klopp and his daughter, Lauren. This unique coastal influenced vineyard located in the Sebastopol Hills sub-region of the Sonoma Coast AVA is characterized by low vigor Goldridge soils, little to no irrigation and daily cool winds. The vineyard is bisected by a ridgetop that creates two distinct aspects, one west and the other east facing. We harvest exclusively from the much cooler east-facing slope.

VARIETAL COMPOSITION: 100% Pinot Noir

VINEYARD: Thorn Ridge Vineyard, Sonoma Coast

TASTING: This pinot noir has pretty aromatics of shaded redwood grove, early fall and that first breeze when you know fall is right around the corner. An approachable pinot noir with flavors of bright red cherry, currants and cranberries finishes with a whisper of earth, autumn woods and a hint of cedar.
