2022 ROSÉ || SONOMA COUNTY

For our 2022 vintage, we have continued to source from Sonoma County and expand the palette of varietals we work with for our Banshee Rosé. We source from select vineyards including parts of our Single Vineyard program, and the final blend is comprised of six varietals produced from six sub-appellations within the Sonoma County AVA.

VARIETAL COMPOSITION: 46% Pinot Noir, 25% Sangiovese, 20% Petite Sirah, 3% Black Muscat, 3% Carignan, 2% Syrah

VINEYARD: 100% Sonoma County

TASTING: The 2022 Sonoma County Rosé is a lovely shade of pale salmon with aromas of floral, tutti-frutti bubblegum and fresh watermelon. Bright, mouth-watering flavors of juicy watermelon are highlighted by hints of minerality and a soft yet crisp finish. Racy acidity and elegance are balanced perfectly in this dry, crisp rosé.



2021 PINOT NOIR || ANDERSON VALLEY

This Banshee Pinot Noir comes from a combination of vineyards in Anderson Valley: Middleridge Ridge Ranch Vineyard and Bearmen Bend Vineyard. Middleridge Ridge Vineyard sits between two ridges above the town of Boonville on a 160-acre ranch with open, rolling hills and panoramic views of Anderson Valley. This vineyard is influenced by warm western winds, sun exposure and warmer temperatures leading to riper, more fruit driven flavors. Bearmen Bend Vineyard is at the "deep end" of the valley located near the town of Philo at 480 feet elevation. This cool climate vineyard produces intense, dark fruit with structured tannins due to the coastal influences of wind and fog from its proximity to the Pacific Ocean.

VARIETAL COMPOSITION: 100% Pinot Noir

VINEYARDS: 81% Middle Ridge Vineyard, 19% Bearmen Bend Vineyard

TASTING: This rustic pinot noir that hails from near the Mendocino coast has a flavor profile of earthy forest and mushroom with hints of ripe olive and graham cracker. Think of digging in to the "nuts & chews" See's candy box! Finishes with smooth acid, a beautiful balance of tannins and a hint of black tea.



2019 CARIGNAN || MENDOCINO COUNTY

Our Carignan fortuitously came to our attention by a truck driver delivering Pinot to us. José, the driver, kept bugging us to come check out his backyard Carignan which we finally relented to seeing. Its vines were about 40 years old and organically farmed to boot. Perched on a ridgetop overlooking Lake Mendocino and grown in beautiful red volcanic loam soils, we're sure glad we followed up on these grapes.

VARIETAL COMPOSITION: 100% Carignan

VINEYARD: Colombini Vineyard, Mendocino County

TASTING: The 2019 Mendocino Carignan is deep, inky and dark with spice cake, clove and cigar box aromas. A smooth entry of rich flavors awakens the palate with juicy acidity, ripe fig and a hint of cola, licorice and oak. This big, masculine wine with a strong tannin backbone is perfect to enjoy cozied up by the fire.
